Ordinances- Health & Safety – Settles

Water – Shaffer

- High Water usage report was not reported as we are estimating.
- Shaffer is still working on water ordinance water rates and wording. We will have a special meeting to finish the ordinance and approve.
- Discussed Black box filter at the water plant. It is not displaying anything on the screen. Steve W. is having someone come look at it.
- Pre-screening for EPA will work with Tim.

Sewer - Brown

- Discussed Farnsworth Group bill. Board voted to pay \$5,000.00 that was contracted to do, and only once we receive the map we let them use of the sewer in Waynesville.
- Tim F. will call Farnsworth and let them know the board's decision.
- Randy F. indicated 37 residences left to be inspected for septic and will be up to date.
- Discussed looking into Water Products to see if price quotes on sewer and water tools, products might be cost saving.
- Will table fence issue at 302 E St. until Spring.

Street and Alleys – Wahls

- Discussed vacated alley at 102 S. West St. for Jack Sampson. Will have Jack sign a form waiving his portion of the alley and re-file and have it recorded.

Finances – Bristow & Cummings

- Tax levy was signed and filed with Courthouse.

Miscellaneous

- Tree Committee has found out more information in order to receive a grant. Our Mayor will need to make an official Arbor Day for the village being April 24th, 2026. Shaffer is looking into finding some trees that can be donated. We will research the best trees to plant in town. Will reach out to get community involved, 4-H kids, Library kids or anyone that would be interested.
