The **Minutes of September** meeting were reviewed by the Board. Wahls motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Settles seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

Ordinances- Health & Safety – Settles

- Discussed ordinance of properties that have been taken care of and ones that have not. We will be sending the Animal Ordinance to John Hoblit to have him verify what we can amend in the ordinance.
- John Hoblit stated that back taxes are taken care of for 103 S. Maltby Street and deed is now in Laken and Mariah Settles name.

Water – Shaffer

- High Water usage report was reviewed.

- Board discussed 2 pages of the water ordinance. Shaffer will continue to work on ordinance and see how other town ordinances are wrote.
- Shaffer found information on a grant through Rural Development for water meters. It is a slow process and a lot of paperwork. Still looking for grants.

Sewer - Brown

- We have received a complaint regarding seeping sewage at 512 S Isham St. Our attorney, John Hoblit will be sending a letter to them regarding this issue.
- Randy is working on a couple of residents' sewer lines and storm tiles.
- Brown discussed starting to work on Farnsworth proposal. We do not have the funds at this time to get it started. We are looking for grants. Tim will be contacting Sally Turner to see if there are any grants available.
- Will check with John Hoblit to see what we are able to increase the sewer amount each month.

Street & Alley – Wahls

- Randy will be finishing up trimming trees.

Finances – Bristow & Cummings

- Discussed starting to work on budget for next year

Miscellaneous

- Randy reported a main line wire is down and frayed coming out of pumphouse that is exposed to the weather. He talked to Kimber Electric and will cost \$1,185.00 to fix.
- Tree committee reported they received a qualification checklist, and Shaffer will email or call the person that can help them complete the application.

Shaffer motioned to adjourn the meeting, Brown seconded.
